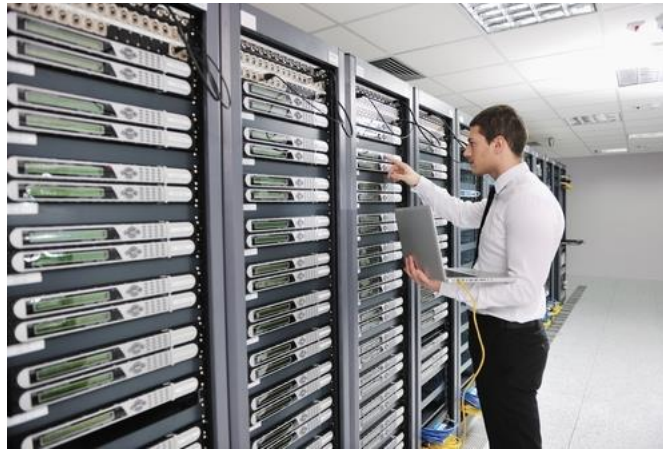
# Manual Contact Tracing

Infected people asked to provide:

- full name
- date of birth
- sex
- NHS Number
- home postcode and house number
- telephone number and email address
- COVID-19 symptoms, including when they started and their nature
- the contact details of anyone they have been in close contact with



# Retention

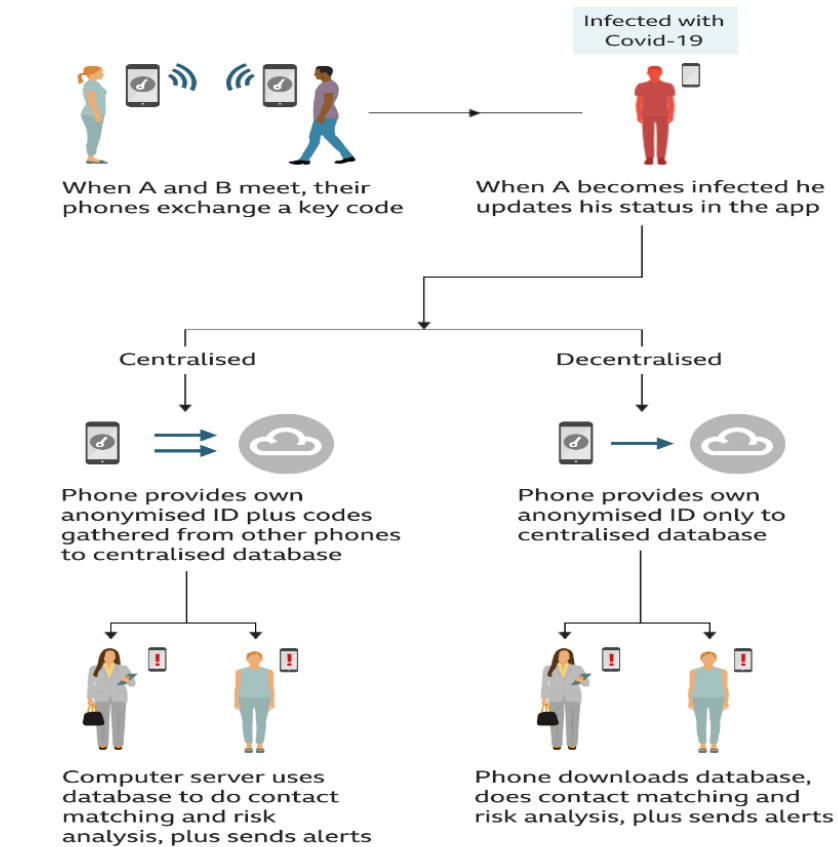


Privacy Notice says:

- 20 years if ‘symptoms’, 5 years if not?
- Not used for any purpose ‘*not linked to COVID-19*’
